Park at the pier at Bunagee, and take a lane by a locked gate and "No Camping" signs to a fisherman's storeage area just beyond. Walk along a path to a picnic area with stone tables, which is a fine place to camp provided you are a climber and have obtained permission from John Henry McLaughlin at Inishowen Motors (tel 00353 7493 70605).

There is a Promontary Fort above and to the left, and the routes are on the various walls, inlets, and points, thereabouts. Routes are described left-to-right.



DOG FISH BAY is the right-most / easterly bay, with climbs, and its climbs are on the left wall as you look seawards, but the climbs are poor quality and are not included here (see Colmcille online guide for details).

Follow the old fishermens' permissive path connecting Dunowen Wall with the other crags (which had been closed by the landowner, but which is now open again) over a stile, and half way across the field, cross the fence on the right on another stile, and descend a gully to a bouldery beach. The Crab's Claw is just ahead, and to the west the arete of Thessalonians etc, beyond this Himalayan Wall, which gives the longest routes in the area.

Please do not take dogs to Dunowen. Please be careful when crossing the walls and replace any stones that you may knock off. If you cross the land you do so at your own risk.

Directions: Follow the old fisherman's permissive path connecting Dunowen Wall with the other crags beyond (This was closed by the landowner, but is now open again) over a stile, through a field, and over a wall, before descending to the shore. Ahead, you will see a castle-like buttress, this is Brazil Rock! About 10 mins walk, 15 from the pier at Bunagee.

Brasil Rock/Canny's Port

Moving uphill and rightwards behind Brasil Rock will bring you to a rock face, in what is known locally as Canny's Port (the former land owner). Access base of crag via a grassy descent at back of the port. Routes start on seaward facing end.

Galavoir Point

Between Bunagee and Glengad, Galavoir can be approached either along the coast from Bunagee Pier, past Brasil Rock, and over the Bens, 20-30 mins, or by a minor road. By road from Culdaff, follow the Glengad road past the Bunagee Pier turn, then take the first right, up the hill. After about a mile, the road goes left, but turn right at Gr 529516, up a private lane and park considerately at Gr 530518, a bend beside a gate, with space for about 2 cars. The owner, Alan Norris, is very accommodating, but treat his property with respect, and no dogs! Through the gate, in a westerley direction, over an old wall and a fence, and descend over rough ground towards the point. Jura wall is on your right, and almost at the point, descend left, down a gully to Glengad Wall on the right. Wavecrest rocks are just beyond Glengad Wall, to the west.

Dunmore Head- Inland Wall

Directions:

The most popular crag in Inishowen, if not Donegal, owing to its convenience and the huge concentration of routes at all grades, some of which are excellent.

In the centre of Culdaff village there is a small village green and Post Office where the Coastal Scenic Road joins the main Moville/ Culdaff Road. Follow this coastal road east from Culdaff village for approx. 3km.

Ample parking can be had at the car park opposite the caravan park, or (for a few cars only)in a small parking space above the bend in the road opposite the crag. Take care to take the seaward side of the perimeter fence of the bungalow between the car park and the crag, and not to block access to the house, or the road/track to the small port below.

Dunmore Head - Left, or Seaward crag

Directions: These are the outcrops left of the highest and most popular crag. They are described left to right, but further left again are shorter rocks around the gap leading to the head. These outcrops need regular attention to prevent them becoming overgrown and difficult of access.

Beyond the gap, is a seaward facing wall, with a couple of routes, most of which are very poor quality. The only quality route being "Black Perception" a corner/slab of compact Black rock, the longest route in Culdaff, at Sev 4a.

Directions:

A delightful cragette. To get to it from the top of the main crag, go over the headland in a North-East direction until you arrive at the top of the crag overlooking the sea.

Alternatively walk to the immediate skyline (above the main crag) and go through the gate, below and right, follow the path on the wall's left hand side; towards the sea. This approach gains the base of the crag easily.
